



VILLA PANIGAI



CONEGLIANO: CITY OF ART AND WINE



from the farm Villa Panigai to Conegliano 20 Km

Discovering the enological and gastronomic tradition and culture of these lands, as well as some examples of local culture and art.

Passing through the hamlet of Soligo you will find the Colle San Gallo. We advise you to drive up the paved road that leads up to the hill, where you will find a small church and you can admire a view of the shores of Soligo, Solighetto and Follina but also of the small villages that make up the Quartier del Piave. On clear days with the clear sky, you can also see the dome of San Marco in Venice. Continuing you will find **VILLA BRANDOLINI**, one of the most significant of the Venetian villas, gracefully restored and it is a splendid setting and showcase for exhibitions and events, you can visit its garden. Pass through Refrontolo, the town of the sweet red wine.

We advise you to make a stop at the **MOLINETTO DELLA CRODA**, which you can visit and take a short walk.

In San Pietro di Feletto, where you can visit the Pieve, a splendid work from the Lombard era, it was erected around the year one thousand but already since the 7th and 8th centuries it was the meeting place for the faithful who flocked to the numerous religious services.

You will reach the descent of the Ca 'de Poggio wall, one of the features made famous by the tour of Italy, and you will also find the eponymous restaurant that returns from one of the best restaurants in the area for location and food. Going down the slope of Ca 'de Poggio continue towards the city of Conegliano, you can visit the old part of the city which is located in **Via XX Settembre**. In the old part you will find the Fountain of the Horses, **Piazza Cima**, the cathedral and in the upper part the Castle of Conegliano. Piazza Cima, a square dedicated to the 15th century artist Cima da Conegliano, some of his works are now in the National Gallery in London but we can admire one of his works "la Pala" inside the city's cathedral in via XX Settembre which represents the Madonna enthroned with Child between angels and saints.

You can reach the **CASTLE OF CONEGLIANO** on foot (30 minutes), following the road in pebbles that is behind Piazza Cima or by car following the indications. The castle of Conegliano is the medieval hub of the Veneto region. Located on the top of the Colle di Giano, in a strategic place, the castle dominates the whole city and the surrounding territory. Inside the tower you can visit the **Civic Museum** of the city (payment € 2.50 per person, closed on Mondays).

A weekend in June takes place in Piazza Cima la Dama Castellana, a historic event in the city where ladies and knights wearing vintage clothes parade with music and flags.
